

Introducing the RAFEA League



Why? In order to get us all going again, inspire some motivation to get out competing again, bring us all together in a Covid-19 secure way, have some fun, but also encourage each other to be competitive – we introduce the RAFEA League.

Who? Totally inclusive, open to all levels – Grassroots to Senior +, dependants, Civil Service – whole force. You can enter as many different horses as you like, or even share horses (each horse & rider combination will be a new entry into the league). You can enter whichever disciplines you like, and even do different disciplines on different horses. This league just for fun – it is not a military league but can include results from military comps once they are up and running again.

When? Any competition you attend, whether military, civilian, affiliated or unaffiliated can count. There are scorings per discipline, based on making the points system fair whether you were at a busy or quiet show. Please note that participants will be bound by the British Equestrian (formerly BEF) rules on resumption of activity, in line with the UK Government's 'road-map'. These rules are based on the government advice for England only, individuals will be responsible for checking for and complying with any differences in restrictions if they live in Scotland, Wales or N Ireland.

Resumption of 'on-duty' activity will be in line with DRS' guidance and will be authorised on an event by event basis. Absolutely nothing is 'on-duty' and no uniform or branded kit is to be worn out and about until specifically advised otherwise.

How? All you need to do is email Fg Off Nina Wilkinson to register your place in the league, you will be sent your Horse & Rider Combo Serial number and a copy of the rules. Then every time you compete, simply email the details over. For full details of how to register, and what to include in your entries, PSB instructions.

Prizes: There will be awards at the end of the season, for:

- 1st 2nd 3rd Military in each level category.
- 1st 2nd 3rd Dependant/Civil Service in each level category.
- Individual who entered the most competitions over the season (across all levels).
- Saddle Club or Unit who had the highest number of riders (across all levels).

To initially register yourself into the league:

- Name
- Rank (If dependant, state dependant)
- Unit/ Saddle Club
- Horse's Name
- Which Discipline League (D, SJ or Eventing, or all of them)

To enter your results:

- Horse & Rider Combo Serial No (if known, otherwise simply state name + horse's name)
- Show Date
- BS/BD/BE or UA?
- Level
- Result (Placing)
 - Dressage:
 - ✓ Include your %
 - SJ:
 - ✓ Include if you got a Double Clear (regardless of placing)
 - Eventing:
 - ✓ Include whether traditional format or Arena Style with no Dressage
 - ✓ Include Dressage Score (if applicable)
 - ✓ Include if you got a Double Clear (regardless of placing)
